DRESS CODE: MYcroSchool students are required to wear navy blue collared, polo-type shirts OR our school t-shirt and khaki slacks or shorts. Shorts must be knee-length. Male students must wear belts. Students may not wear baggy pants. Students are not permitted to wear hoodies in classes, hallways, or in common areas of school.

CELL PHONES: Students are required to secure cell phones upon entering our school. A second violation of this policy will result in an immediate 3-day suspension.

FOOD & DRINKS: **FREE breakfast and lunch** is provided to all of our students each day. Students may bring their own food for consumption and eat **during scheduled meal times only:**

7:45 - 8:00 am - Breakfast and **12:45 - 1:00 pm** - Lunch.

HALL & BATHROOM PASSES: Students must adhere to our hall and bathroom pass policies. Students are not permitted to be out of assigned classrooms without a hall or bathroom pass except during fire drills or school emergencies.
